





The Sea Dragon King loved his only daughter and wanted her to be happy.






They were elementary school classmates and often played together in the ocean waves.







They went fishing in the ocean for food, played in the mountains for fun, and made lots of friends.





But the Sea Dragon King was so sad. He promised to find his daughter and kill the Tortoise General.


After two years, the Sea Dragon King found them. He was so angry that he made a huge thunderstorm and a great flood.



The Tortoise General and the Kavalan Princess tried to stay together, but the water was too strong and the Tortoise General was washed out to sea.




The Sea Dragon King saw that his daughter was very sad. He didn't kill the Tortoise General, but he didn't let him come back to Yilan either.
